- · How does the project/activity/service involve analysis, evaluation, problem solving and decision making?
- · What new skills do participants gain through their involvement with the project/activity/service?

3. Builds a strong sense of confidence, competence and/or community awareness in others

Suggested details to consider:

- Within his/her role, what does the citizen do to develop trust and/or promote individual empowerment for other participants or students?
- How did the citizen demonstrate effective communication and organization?
- How did the citizen demonstrate creativity?
- How did the citizen encourage social responsibility in others?
- How did the citizen encourage participants to build their own skills?

4. Generates measurable impacts that leave a positive legacy

Suggested details to consider:

- What were the primary goals or objectives of the project/activity/service?
- Based on those goals, has the project/activity/service been a measurable success?
- How many people (estimate) were impacted by the project/activity/service?
- How will the impact of the project/activity/service be measured in years to come?
- How did the citizen's project/activity/service result in a sustainable model for others to follow?
