Together, they co-founded a Crafts Club at Lakeridge High School. The club meets weekly to make beautiful jewelry and sell the jewelry as a fundraiser. All of the proceeds are donated to Doernbecher's Children's Hospital at OHSU.

As co-founder of the Crafts Club, Nancy invests about two hours weekly, making jewelry during and outside

of meetings to ensure that there is enough to be sold. All of the jewelry is sold with the intention to support children in need. Nancy is extremely patient with other club members and is invested in earning money to donate.

Nancy provides community service in many additional ways.
